Subject: Grade Level Placements for 2010-11 and 2011-12 - ACTION

ACTION:

That the Board of Education approve the grade level placements for the following school sites as noted:

Central	*Move K-1 SDC to Redwood Shores Elem. *Move 20 K students to Nesbit *If extra fifth grade needed, K will move sooner	*Move 2 K classes to Nesbit
Cipriani	* Move 2 K classes to Nesbit (retain 2 classes of K = 40 students)	*Gain 1 class of 1 st graders and one 1 st grade class remain at Nesbit. *Move 2 K classes to Nesbit (retain 2 classes of K = 40 students)
Fox	*Double up pre-school	*Move County Sp. Ed. program to Sandpiper
Nesbit	*Double up pre-school *Gain 20 K from Central *Gain 2 K classes from Cipriani	*Take one day care room *Gain 2 K classes from Central *Gain 2 K classes from Cipriani

BACKGROUND

The Board has requested a plan to accommodate student enrollment growth without having to add new portables or permanent classroom space. The recommendations presented include discussion from prior board meetings and community meetings. These projections do not include new students due to new housing development or potential students coming from private school. Growth for special education has also not projected in this plan.

Staff's recommendation is to move forward with this plan so registration can begin with a message to parents that we will be capped at our school sites and new students may need to be placed in another site. Open enrollment procedures will be brought to the board at a later date with any updates or changes that staff may need to make on these procedures.

The Board has heard from various parents that they would like to have the District consider placing portables at impacted sites. If the Board decides to consider a plan that incorporates adding new portables we will make necessary adjustments as needed and will bring modified grade level placement changes at a future meeting.

At the conclusion of the meeting, the Board will inform staff of next steps in preparing action items for portables at sites.
